

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLONOSCOPY SU-PREP

If you are taking medications (including aspirin-containing products), iron supplements or Pepto-Bismol, consult your physician for additional instructions prior to beginning this procedure.

- 1. If you are a diabetic and are taking insulin or oral medications, please do not take it on the day of the procedure.**
- 2. Do not take any blood thinner such as Coumadin, or any aspirin-containing product for at least 5 days prior to your procedure. Consult with your physician prior to discontinuing medication.**
- 3. Take all other medication unless instructed otherwise by the physician. Take with a sip of water.**
- 4. Obtain the following from your pharmacist: 1. Magnesium Citrate 2. Su-prep**

Clear Liquid Diet: This includes strained fruit juices without pulp (apple, white grape, lemonade), water, sprite, 7 up, clear chicken / beef broth or bouillon, Gatorades or jello's (NO RED, PURPLE, OR ORANGE) and tea or coffee (without milk sugars or non-dairy creamer). **NO DAIRY PRODUCTS WHILE ON CLEAR LIQUID DIET.**

- 5. One day Prior to the procedure: Date: _____**
(Clear liquid diet for breakfast, lunch and dinner)
 - a) 9:00 a.m. Take one bottle of Magnesium Citrate
 - b) 6:00 p.m. Take full-dose of **Su-prep** (mixed with 16-ounces of water)

In addition, take 1 liter (approx 32 oz) of additional water over the next hour.

DO NOT EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT (except for the Su-Prep)

6. Day of procedure: Date _____

- a) **6 hours before procedure:** Take the second liter of **Su-Prep** solution over one hour.

Arrival Time: CONTACT FACILITY FOR ARRIVAL TIME.

Instructions for Colonoscopy Su- Prep

A colonoscopy is a valuable test for detailed evaluation of your colon. During the colonoscopy, your physician looks at the inside of your colon by using a thin flexible telescope. Preparation before colonoscopy is very important for a safe and good quality examination. Your colon must be completely empty and clean. The following instructions (prep) will help you complete this task. If your colon is not empty and clean, the physician will not be able to clearly see inside your colon using the scope, the physician then might abort the procedure before completion and ask you to repeat the prep and procedure at a later day.

1. If you are taking iron supplements, please hold it for 5 days prior to this procedure.
2. If you are a diabetic and are taking insulin or oral medication, please do not take it on the day of the procedure.
*** PLEASE NOTIFY DR. DACCAK'S OFFICE IF ON INSULIN ***
3. Do not take any blood thinner, such as Coumadin, Plavix, or ticlid for at least 5-7 days prior to your procedure as instructed. However, you must **CONSULT YOUR PHYSICIAN PRIOR TO DISCONTINUING YOUR MEDICATION.**
4. Take all other medications **EVEN ON THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE** unless instructed otherwise by the physician. Take with a sip of water.
5. **Obtain the Su-Prep and Magnesium Citrate from your pharmacist.**
6. **You must pre-register through the outpatient dept. of the facility.**

You must complete all steps of the prep; even if stool is clear prior to completion. If not, it may result in procedure being stopped and rescheduled. If you have any questions about these instructions, or the procedure, please do not hesitate to contact our office directly at 713-910-7779.
